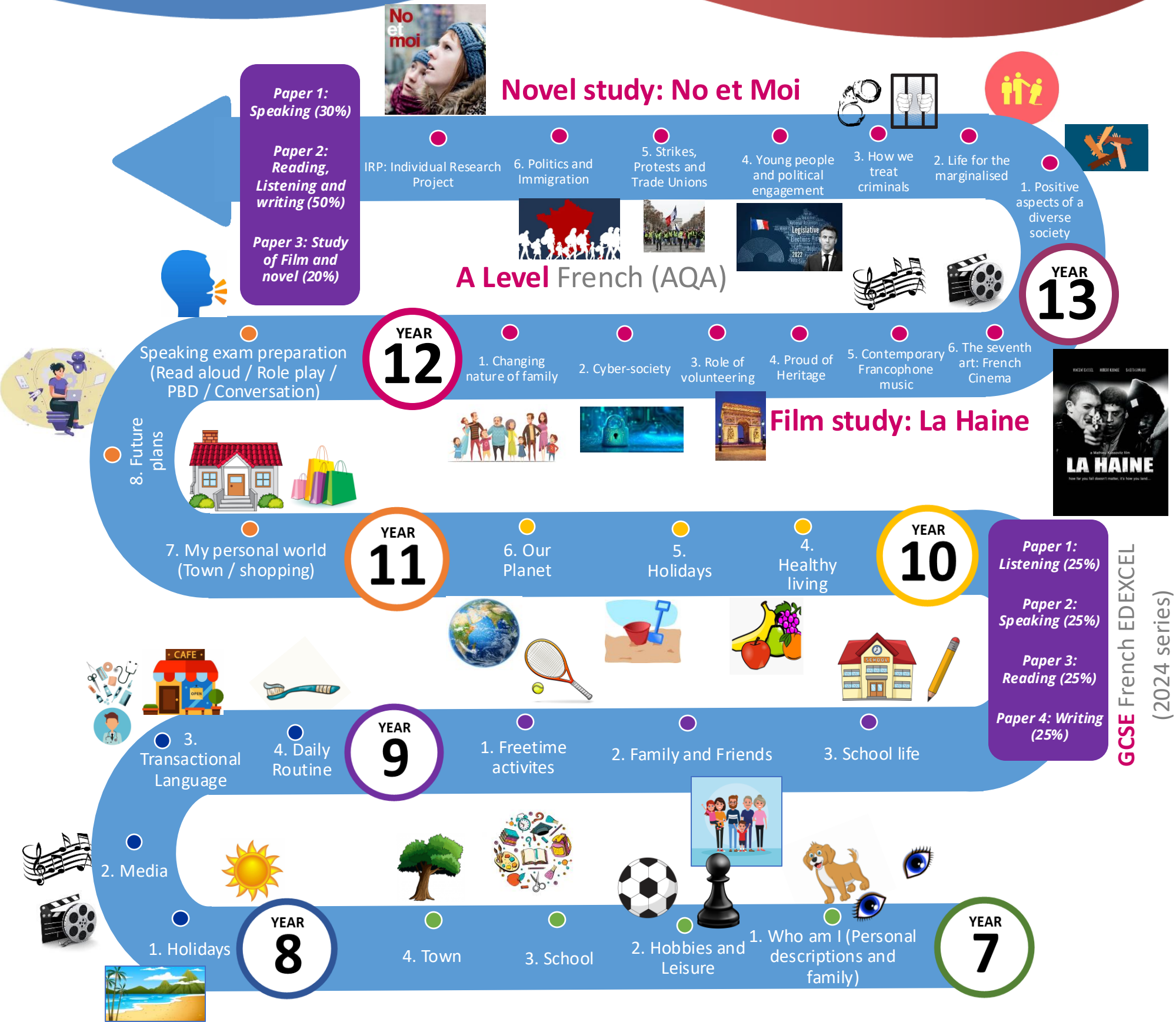


# WELCOME TO Modern Foreign Languages (French)
