**INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT: VOLUNTARY AIDED SCHOOL**

1. The name of the school is Hutton Church of England Grammar School
2. The school is a voluntary aided school
3. The name of the governing body is "The Governing Body of Hutton Church of England Grammar School "
4. The school has a trust deed dated 1552
5. The ethos statement of this voluntary school is:

Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.

6. The governing body shall consist of:
  - (a) 3 parent governors
  - (b) 1 local authority governor
  - (c) 1 staff governor
  - (d) 1 headteacher
  - (e) 9 foundation governors
  - (f) 1 co-opted governor
7. The total number of governors is: 16

8. (a) The Diocesan Board of Education for the Diocese of Blackburn appoints foundation governors
  - (i) 4 on the nomination of the Principal Officiating Ministers for the Parishes of Penwortham St Mary, Penwortham St Leonard, Longton St Andrew, Farington St Paul and New Longton All Saints
  - (ii) 4 on the nomination of the Parochial Church Councils for the e Parishes of Penwortham St Mary, Penwortham St Leonard, Longton St Andrew, Farington St Paul and New Longton All Saints
- (b) The Hutton Church of England Grammar School Foundation appoints 1 governor.
9. This instrument of government comes into effect on 1 September 2015
10. This instrument was made by order of Lancashire local authority on 6 September 2015
11. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the headteacher if not a governor), and to trustees and all bodies which appoint foundation governors
