LIVE LESSON CODE OF CONDUCT

Code of Conduct

- All students engaging in 'live' lessons will behave appropriately at all times, displaying behaviour which would be expected in a normal classroom setting; any student who behaves inappropriately will be 'removed' from the lesson and parental contact made. Subsequent inappropriate behaviour will result in students being removed permanently from future live lessons for all staff
- Students must engage in any live lesson for its entirety, not 'entering' (or requesting entry) late or 'leaving' early
- Students must not take screenshots, or recordings, of any lessons or parts of lessons
- Students must not post, manipulate or in any other manner display images or recordings which are intended for their educational use
- Links to live lessons are for class members only and should not be shared with anyone; joining a live lesson to which students were not directly invited will result permanent removal from future live lessons in all subjects

It is of the utmost importance that parents/carers and students read and understand the code of conduct.

Whilst we fully understand and appreciate that the vast majority of students will behave in the appropriate manner any student who does not follow this code of conduct will be subject to the school's usual sanctions. With regard to posting or other manipulation of images this also includes potential criminal prosecution.
