Dear Students/Parents and Carers,

Welcome to A Level Mathematics at Hutton Church of England Sixth Form and I would like to congratulate all students who have achieved the high grades necessary to continue studying Mathematics at A Level.

You will be aware that the A level specification changed in 2017 and as well as some new content being introduced, there is greater emphasis on the use of technology which means that the calculator suitable for GCSE needs to be upgraded to the **CASIO fx-991EX CLASSWIZ** (unless already purchased). It will also be necessary for students to have access to a text book.

We strongly advise all students to purchase a copy of the text book and it will be **essential** to have the recommended calculator. There will be a small number of copies of the books for use in class but students will not be permitted to take these home. They will therefore need their own copy to complete tasks at home and it will also be useful for students to own the books as this will allow them to make their own notes in the text book to aid with their revision.

We are aware that purchasing books and calculators can result in significant costs for students and with this in mind we have secured a better value price for books by buying them in bulk. We are therefore in a position to offer the following:

This is cheaper than the recommended retail price and the books includes all of the material that will be covered across two years of study at A Level. Students who are eligible for the 16-19 bursary will be able to claim the cost of text books back from their bursary allowance at a later date if they wish.
