Please be thinking in your forms about:-

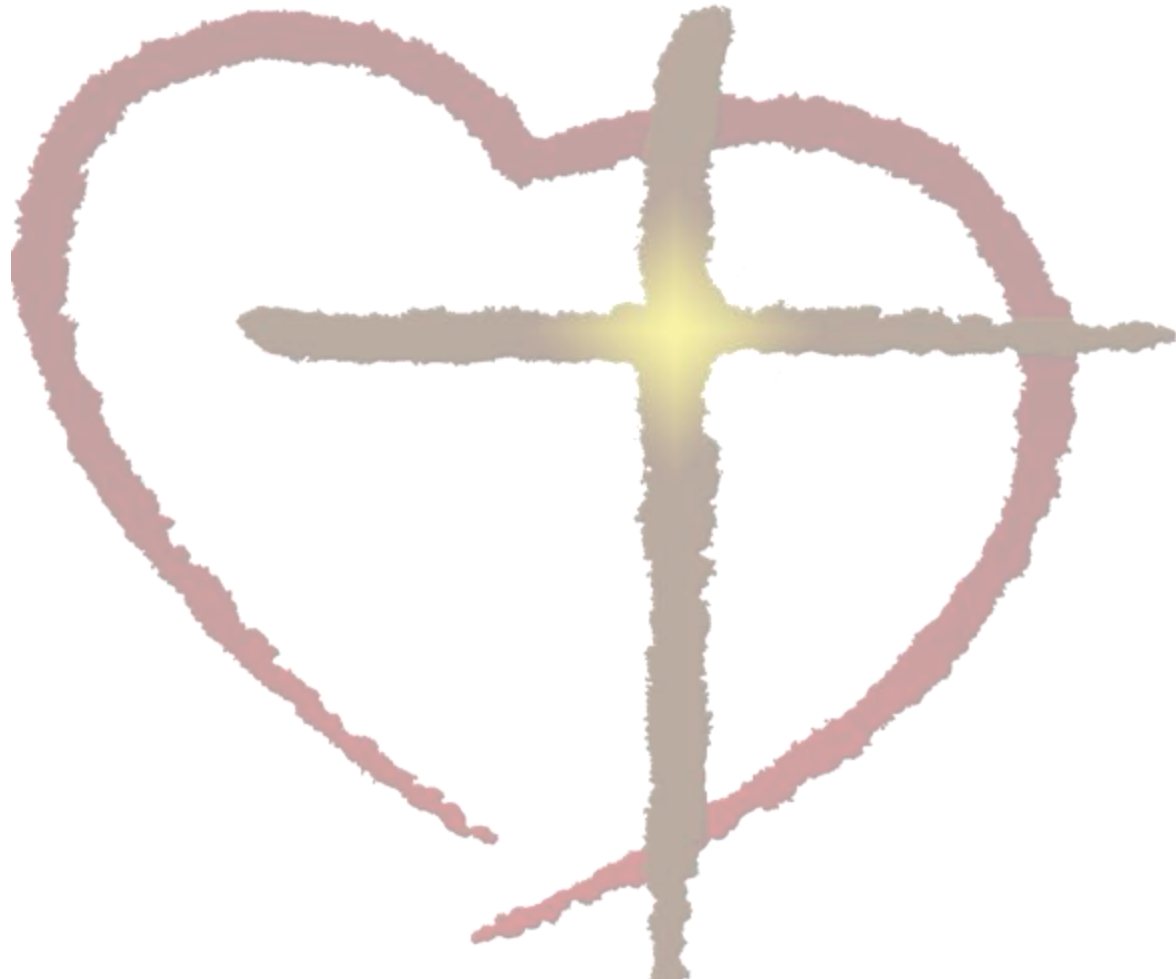
- Form Captain(s): who will represent your form at student council, perhaps complete equipment and uniform checks each day, and read prayers out during form / main worship, etc...

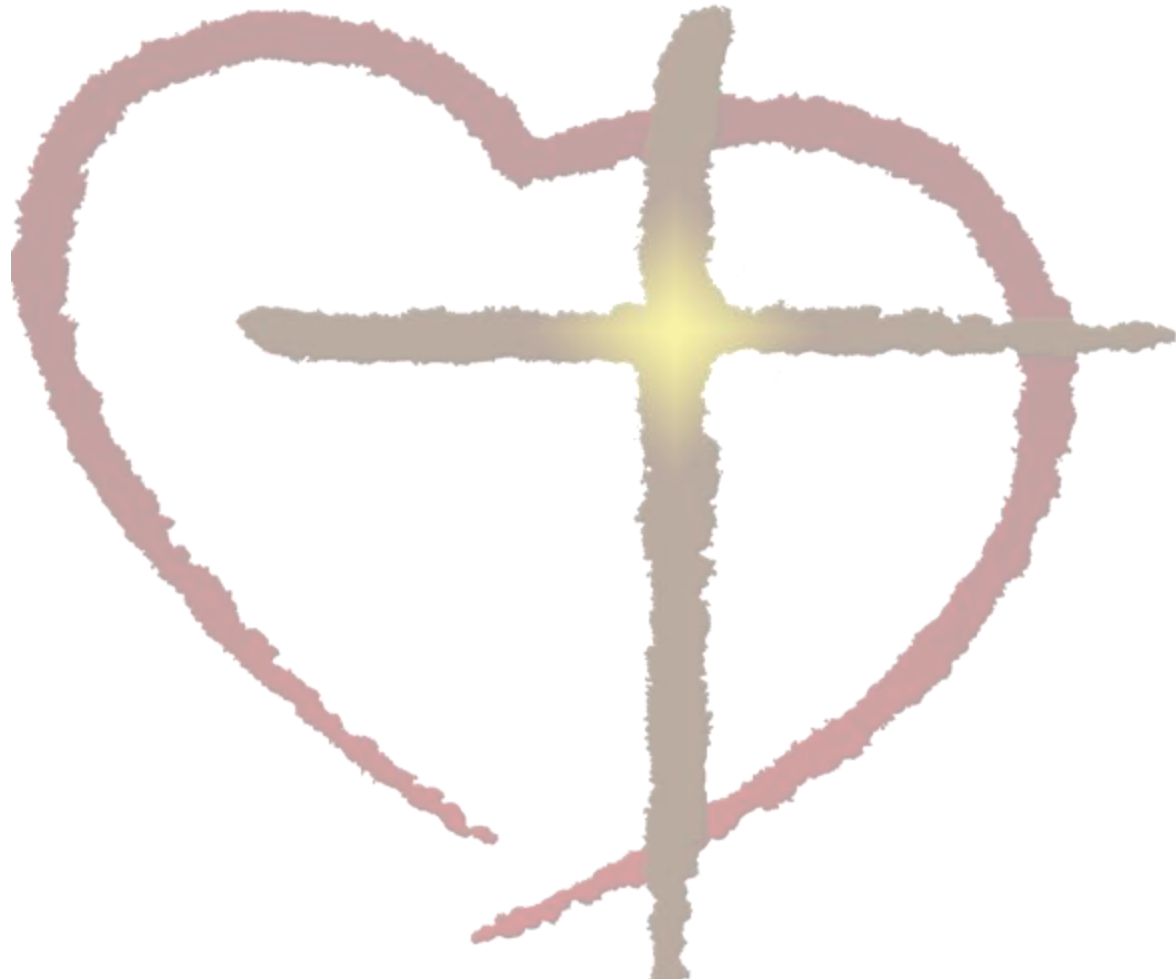
Christian Value(s): Koinonia (living well together) &

Reflection Questions

1. What does koinonia mean and why is it our core value?

Living well together, as a loving and supporting community. It is our core value because loving and caring for each other underpins all other values (peace, justice, compassion, etc...). Everyone is a valued, loved, child of God.

2. How can we live out this value in school & sixth form? Give examples

Don't tolerate bullies / If you have nothing kind to say, don't say anything / Make friends with others / Be honest / Look out for your friends / Don't push in the lunch queue / Say please and thank you / help others / join in / etc...

3. Does it really matter what we say and do? (especially when adults / teachers aren't around...)

Yes – community is still important when pupils and students together when adults aren't around / it is a sign of maturity / it shows integrity and strength of character / You should feel safe at school and 6th form

4. Why might it be important that we endure in living out koinonia, even when we are tired, angry, sad, etc...

Because there is no excuse for treating others unkindly! Part of growing up is managing your emotions & behaviour

Father God,

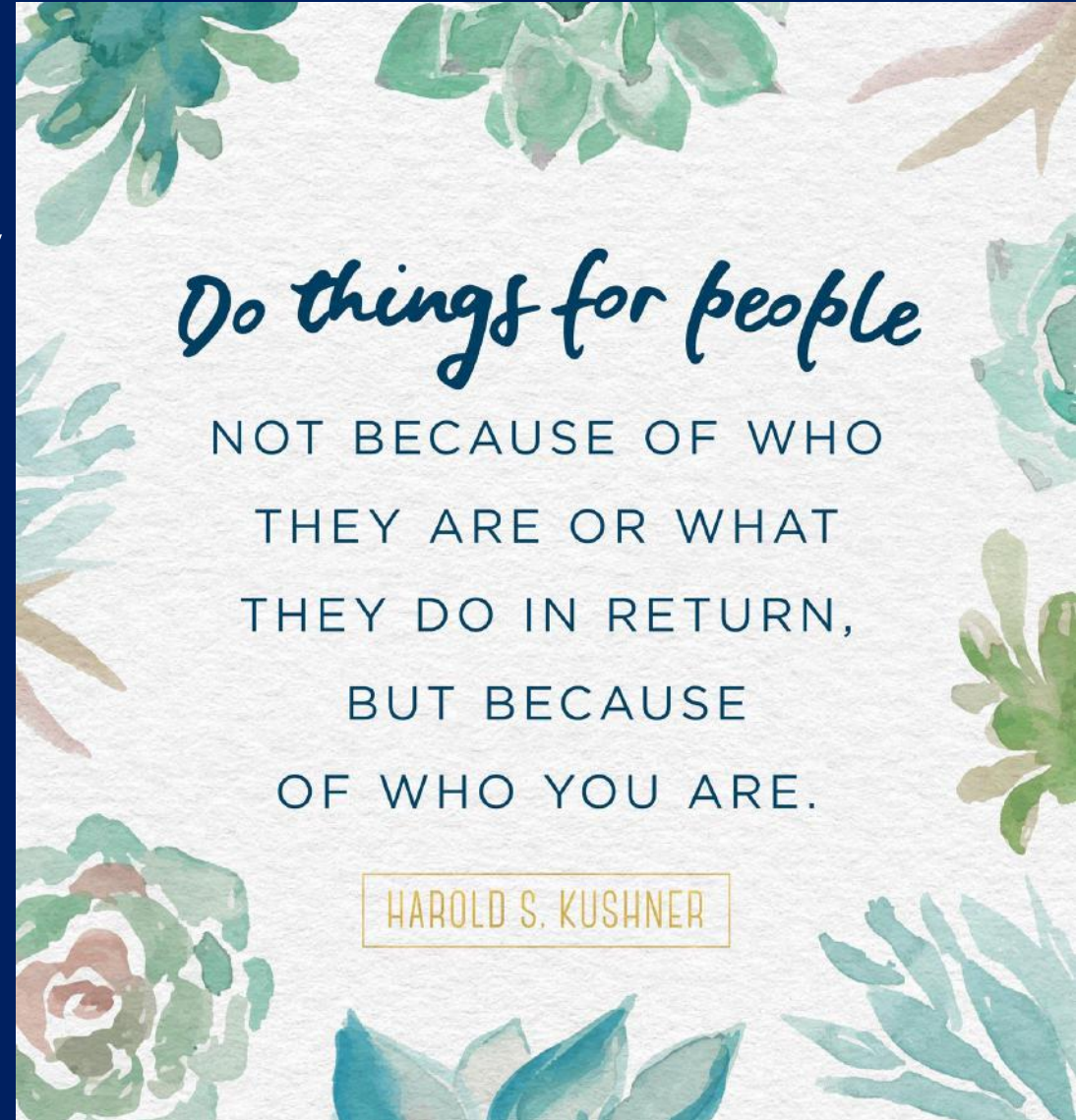
Help us remember that what we do and say affects others.

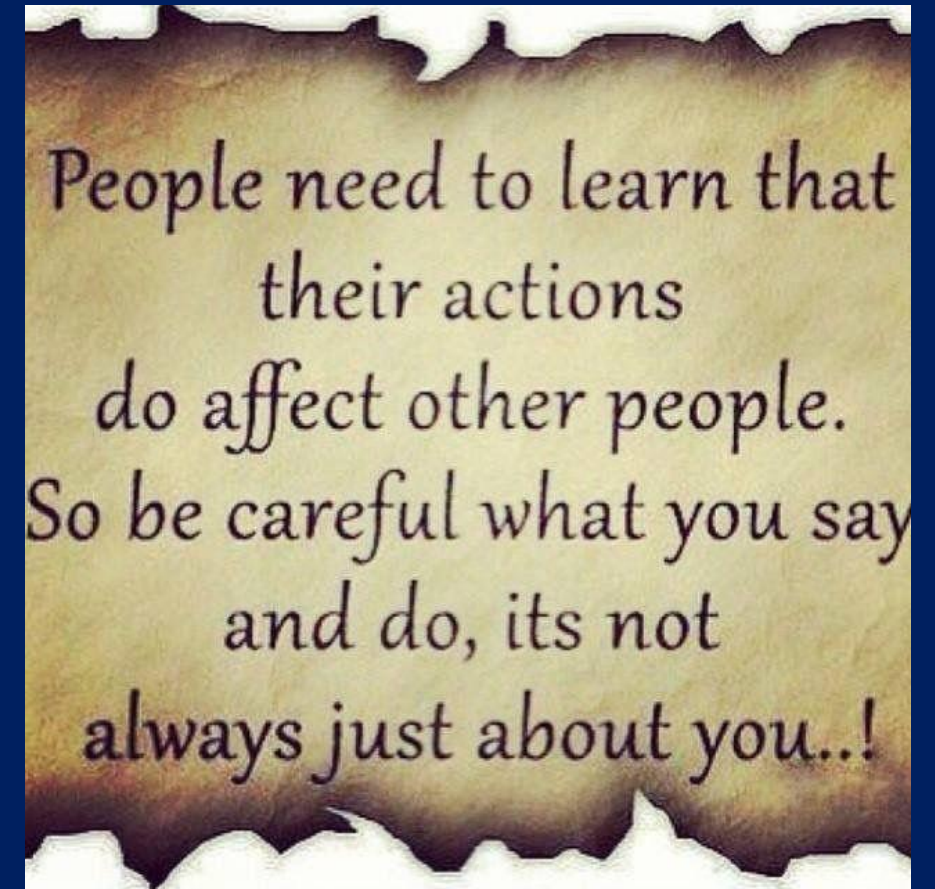


Our School Prayer

Father God,

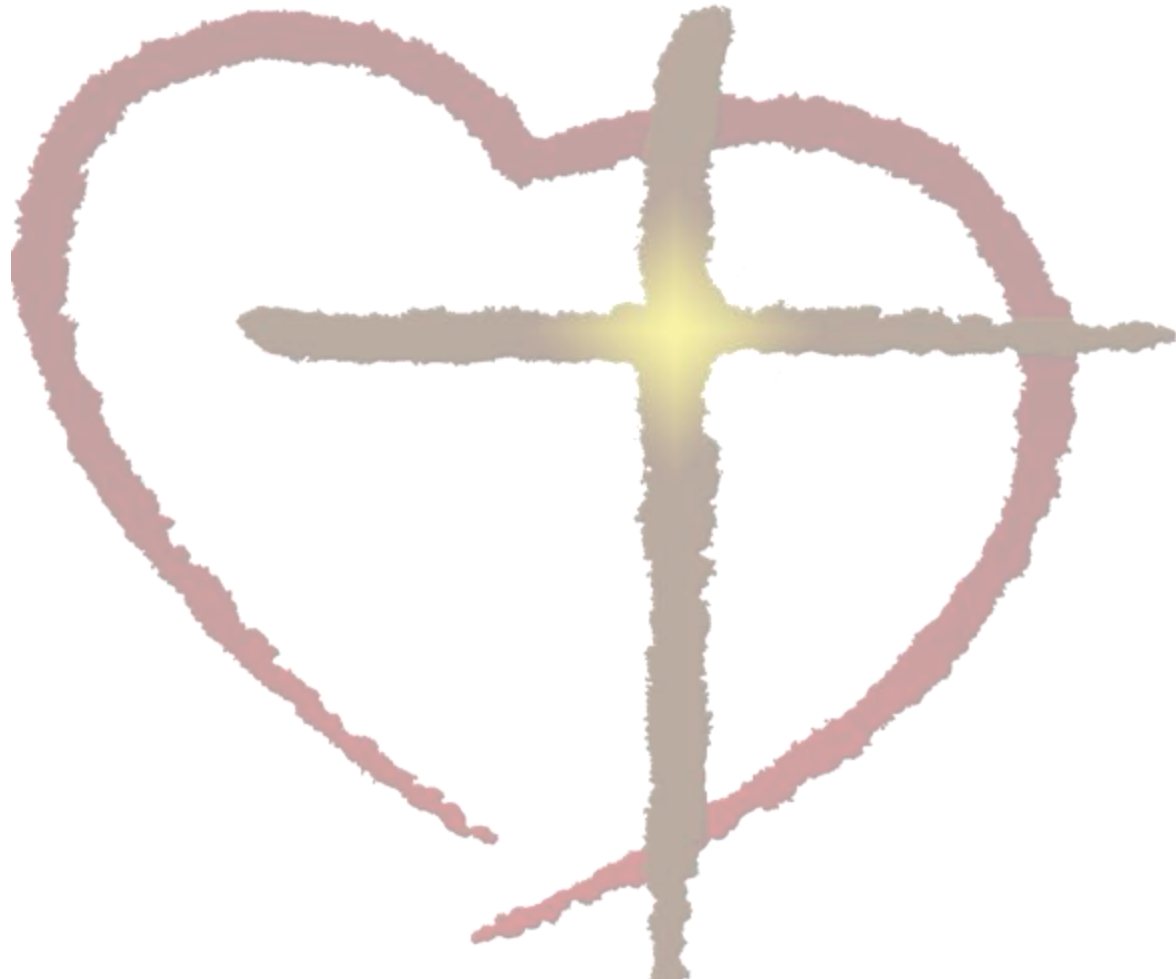
**We pray that on this new day,

Amen.

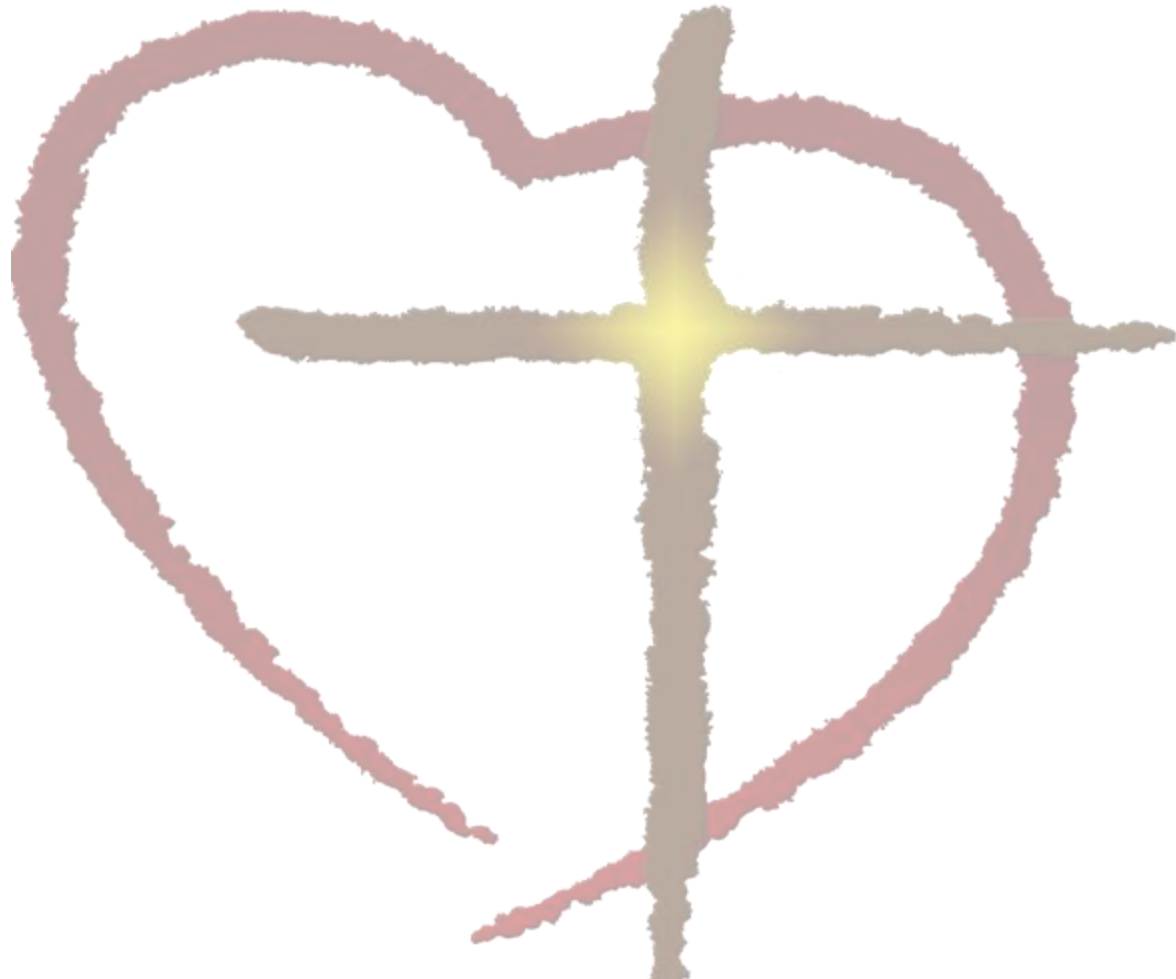

Amen.

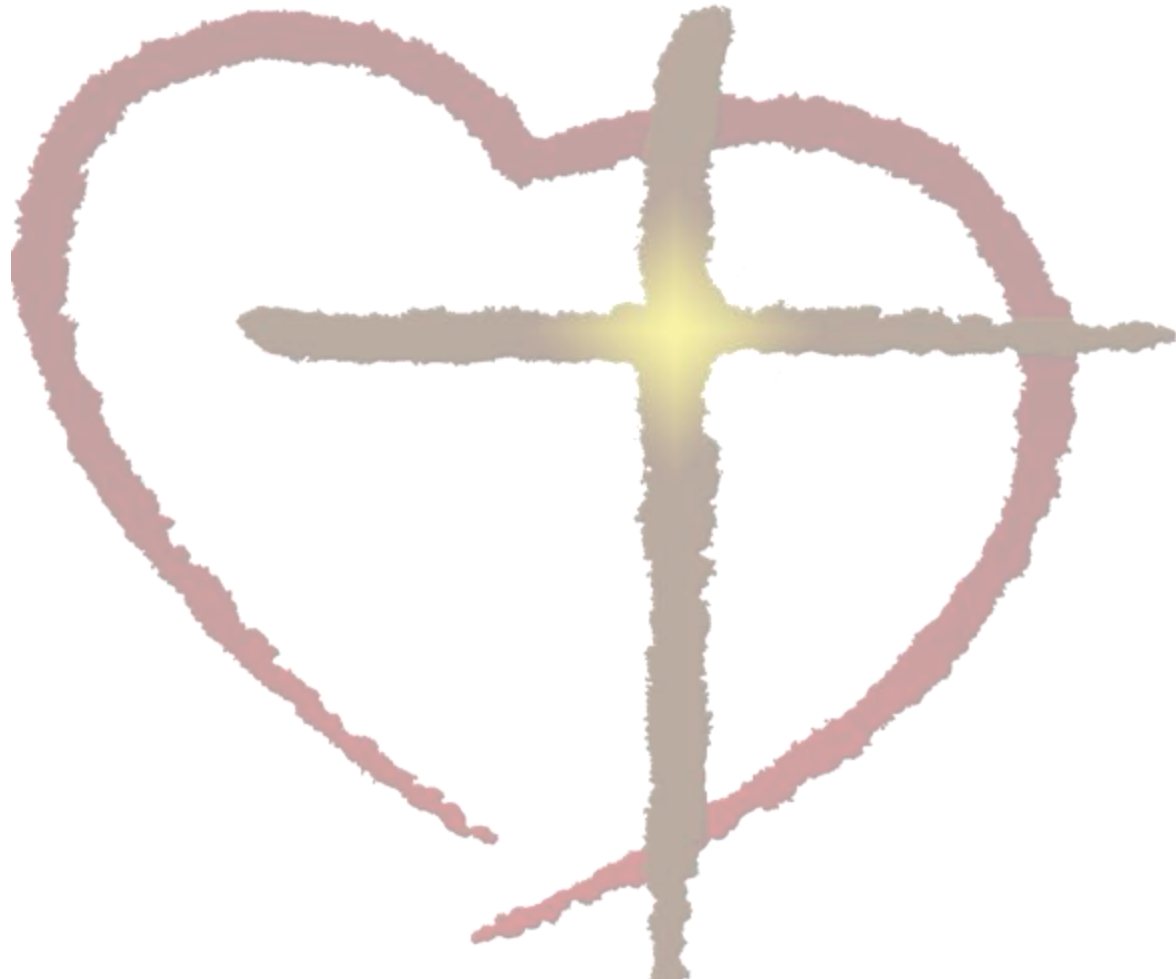
