What is Pupil Premium?

Pupil Premium is additional funding provided to schools to support support pupils, to ensure they benefit from the same opportunities as their peers.

Are you eligible for funding?

Do you meet any of the following criteria?

- The child is recorded as eligible for free school meals, or have been recorded as eligible in the past 6 years.
- The child was previously looked after by a local authority or other state care, including children adopted from state care.
- The child has parent serving in the armed forces.
- The parent(s) is in receipt of Universal Credit with a household income less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get).
- The parent(s) is in receipt of Income Support
- The parent(s) is in receipt of Income-based job seekers allowance
- The parent(s) is in receipt of income-related employment and support allowance.
- The parent(s) is in receipt of support under Part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The parent(s) is in receipt of the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- The parent(s) is in receipt of Child Tax Credit (provided you're not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of less than £16,190).

How is the funding spent?
